

Job Openings in 2021: 1 Full Professor Position

The Department of Economics at the Université Paris-Dauphine (LEDa) invites applications for one position at the level of Full Professor.

Applications are invited in all fields of economics. Candidates whose research lies in one of the areas of specialty of the department may have an advantage. Applicants must have held a Ph.D. or doctorate degree in economics for at least five years and have a well-established record of research and publications. Being able to teach in French is not required but will be appreciated.

The successful candidate should be committed to a state-of-the-art research program and will be expected to teach at the graduate and undergraduate levels 128 hours per year, to supervise doctoral students and to provide senior leadership in the department. The position will start on September 1st, 2021 or on a mutually agreed date. The annual gross salary will be €37,500 – €66,000, depending on experience and qualification.

The position is open to candidates both inside and outside the French university system (Maîtres de conférence and Chargés de recherche in a French public institution must hold the "Qualification" at the time of hire). The position is permanent.

LEDa (75 tenured faculty members) is the economics department of Université Paris-Dauphine, associated with the Centre National de la Recherche Scientifique (CNRS, www.cnrs.fr/en) and the Institut de Recherche pour le Développement (IRD, www.ird.fr/). Please submit, a letter of application, a CV mentioning at least three referees and three representative research papers. Shortlisted candidates will be asked to have their referees submit

three recommendation letters and will be invited to visit our department and give an on-line seminar.

The deadline for application is 15 January 2021. Selected candidates will be invited for an on-line recruitment seminar from 20 January to 12 March 2021. The seminar talk will be followed by bilateral meetings with interested members of the department. A final decision will be taken in April 2021.
