The aim of this SSPH+ workshop is to bring together researchers from different fields working in the area of aging, health, disability and wellbeing. The workshop take stock of ongoing research on aging, health, disability and wellbeing in Switzerland and provide opportunities for interaction with leading international experts and policy makers in the field on how to move the corresponding research agenda forward and how to make it most relevant for practitioners.

While the focus of the workshop will be on social and behavioral science research, researchers from other fields related to aging, health, disability and wellbeing such as biology, engineering or medicine are also welcome to attend and contribute to the workshop.

The workshop will provide opportunities for exchange regarding ongoing research in aging, health, disability and wellbeing, including an exchange between senior and junior researchers and PhD students, networking among like-minded researchers, as well as an exchange of ideas and the development of future collaborative public health research projects, proposals and papers in this research field.

The workshop is open to everyone and is free of charge but places are limited and registration is mandatory. We also strongly encourage attendance of the entire workshop and participants registered for the entire event will receive priority in case of space limitations. Interested research groups and individual researchers are also invited to display their ongoing research projects in the area of aging, health, disability and wellbeing by means of a poster.
